

Cotswold children help the hungry

The \$2890.80 raised by the school was its highest total ever. A total of 60 Cotswold children signed up this year, choosing from

the classic no food famine, as well as other options including no talking, no technology or a themed famine such as living in a box for 40 hours.

The final tally of money raised around New Zealand will not be known until mid-July but the figure currently stands at more than \$650,000. The target is \$3.15 million. More than 145,000 children nationwide registered to complete the famine this year.
